


Fredrick Douglass (1818-1895)

- ❖ American social civil rights activist & abolitionist
- ❖ An abolitionists are people who are against slavery
- ❖ He was born on a plantation in Talbot county
- ❖ After escaping slavery in Maryland, he became a national leader of the abolitionist movement
- ❖ He taught himself how to read and write by observing the white kids



Garrett Morgan (1878-1963)


- Born in Kentucky
- Spent most of his career working as a handyman
- ❖ Morgan had to quit school at a young age and work full-time
- * He has invented many items and products, including:
 - > Sewing machine
 - > Traffic signal
 - ➤ Hair straightening products





Daniel Hale Williams (1856-1931)

- ❖ Born and raised in Pennsylvania
- American general surgeon who performed the first successful pericardium surgery
- He worked to create more hospitals that admitted
 African Americans
